Wedding flowers 101

Not sure where to start with your wedding flowers? Here is a quick guide!

Bouquets - what's the difference in sizing?

I do three 'sizes' of bouquet: Bridal, bridesmaids bouquet and bridesmaids posy.

The bridal bouquet is always the show stopper, with bridesmaids bouquets coming in a little smaller and/or having colour/style differences to allow the bridal bouquet to really stand out!

Posies are great either for your junior bridesmaids, or for saving a little bit of money to spend on a bigger installation or statement bridal bouquet!

Buttonholes & Corsages - what is the difference?

Buttonholes: Worn on the lefthand side of the lapel, these mini bouquets are designed for the important men on your day, generally this is The Groom, Groomsmen and/or ushers, pageboys and fathers/grandfathers - you can have any combination of these wearers, as many or as few as you'd like!

Corsages: A slightly more flamboyant version of a buttonhole designed for the female members of your party; mums, grandmothers, friends and sometimes bridesmaids. These can be worn either on the right side of the lapel or on the wrist.

Where could I have flowers?

There are so many options when it comes to flowers, here are some ideas split by where they fit into your day! If you're not 100% sure what would look best, we can also schedule a venue visit to make the best of the space and budget you have!

Ceremony:

Entrance arrangements/arch, aisle decor, ceremony table/top of aisle, arbour/outdoor pavilion decor, in memory flowers on seats.

Reception:

Top table, guest tables, stair cases (internal or external), balconies, photo backdrops, mantle pieces, hanging installations, balconies.

The details:

Welcome signage, table plan, bar & drinks reception arrangements, loose flowers for detail photos

What should I know before my consultation?

You don't have to know exactly what you want before you get in touch to book your flowers; designing your wedding flowers within your budget is all about shimmying things around and prioritising, with the following two pieces of information we can work together to do this easily:

- 1. What is your approximate maximum spend?
- 2. What are your priorities when it comes to flowers? Is this personal flowers, centrepieces, a gorgeous installation?



What do wedding flowers cost?

If you're going with the pick and mix package then all the costs are on our web shop. Please note these prices will be reviewed and potentially increased every six months so if you're planning to order, order ASAP to avoid price increases.

An average Muck Home & Floral couple spends £1500 on their wedding flowers with us, but that doesn't mean this is your starting point, most of our couples fall anywhere from £1000-£5000.

No matter how much you're choosing to spend on your flowers Muck Home & Floral will design something that suits your taste and your budget as well as complementing your venue.

Below is a price guide for the most common items on my couples floral Wishlist, in addition to this I also charge for delivery if required and on the day labour for setting up/moving your florals at the venue:

The Full package: What's the process?

1. Send us an enquiry via the online form

Completing the enquiry form gives me all the details I need to confirm if I am available to flower your wedding. The more detail you provide here the better picture I get to prepare for our consultation call. You can also send me any images, inspiration and your own mood boards via the email listed on the enquiry page of my website.

2. Schedule a call to discuss your day

I will respond to your enquiry within 24 hours and If I am available to do your wedding flowers we'll get a short call in the diary (45 mins) to discuss your day and the ideas you have for your flowers. These calls run best if you already have an idea of budget in mind as well as some ideas on what's most important to you when it comes to your flowers!

3. We'll prepare your bespoke proposal & Quote

After our call I prepare a moodboard and quote based on what we've discussed, usually this has a few options for you to choose from included; this can take anywhere from a couple of hours to a few days depending on my capacity. This is valid for two weeks from when it's issued, and within this time I will hold your date, unless stated otherwise. I'll also send over a copy of my terms and conditions.

4. Booking your florals

Once you've had the opportunity to read through your proposal and the T&Cs we can either proceed straight away with your deposit to confirm your date in the diary or schedule a further call to confirm any details ahead of confirming your date.

5. Before your wedding day

Once you're booked in I'll get in touch with your venue to pass on my details and confirm any necessary arrangements. If you'd like a venue visit we will get this scheduled, but otherwise I'll be in touch 8-10 weeks before your date to finalise your florals on another call.
